

Take Exit 194 Everett Ave/US-2 towards Wenatchee
Keep Right to take ramp for Everett Ave/WA 529 toward City Center
Turn Right onto Everett Ave/Yellow Ribbon Hwy- WA 529
Take Second Left onto Maple St
Turn Right onto Pacific Ave
