### What's on the Ballot?

- 31<sup>st</sup> Legislative District - State Senator and Representative Position No. 2
- Port of Tacoma
- Cities and Towns - Auburn, Bonney Lake, DuPont, Fircrest, Gig Harbor, Orting, Puyallup, Steilacoom, Tacoma, University Place and Wilkeson
- Puyallup School District No. 3
- Fire Districts - East Pierce Fire and Rescue, FPD No. 17 (South Pierce), FPD No. 18 (Orting Valley) and FPD No. 27 (Anderson Island)
- Park and Recreation Districts - Anderson Island Park and Recreation District, Metropolitan Park District of Tacoma

### Special Elections

#### City of DuPont

Proposition No. 1 – Six-Year Levy Lid Lift for Advance Life Support Services  
Requires 909 Yes votes plus a 60% favorable majority

#### Town of Wilkeson

Proposition No. 1 – Emergency Medical Services Property Tax Levy  
Requires 48 Yes votes plus a 60% favorable majority

#### East Pierce Fire & Rescue (Pierce and King County)

Proposition No. 1 – Levy Lid Lift – Property Tax Levy  
Requires a simple majority

Proposition No. 2 – Levy Lid Lift – EMS Levy  
Requires a simple majority

#### Fire Protection District No. 18 (Orting Valley Fire & Rescue)

Proposition No. 1 – Excess Property Tax Levy for Maintenance and Operations Expenses  
Requires 1,589 Yes votes plus a 60% favorable majority

#### Fire Protection District No. 27 (Anderson Island Fire & Rescue)

Proposition No. 1 – General Obligation Bonds for Capital Improvements - \$1,000,000  
Requires 328 Total votes plus a 60% favorable majority

#### Anderson Island Park and Recreation District

Proposition No. 1 – Maintenance and Operations Property Tax Levy  
Requires 197 Yes votes plus a 60% favorable majority

### August 1 - Election Day

#### Ballot return deadline

Ballots must be postmarked no later than Election Day or placed in a ballot drop box by 8:00 p.m. on Election Night. Voters are encouraged to vote early.
