SUMMARY OF REQUIREMENTS TO OBTAIN A FIREWORKS PERMIT

FIREWORKS STAND/TENT SALES (FBSF)

RENEWEL (had a permit last year)

NEW (did not have a permit last year)

SUBMITTALS REQUIRED:

- Completed permit application
- Detailed site plan (1 electronic copy or 2 paper copies)
- Ortho Photo (aerial photograph) of the stand location is required
 - A parcel ortho photo may be obtained from the PC Assessor's office. Do not use highlighter does not copy
- Insurance certificate (PC Code 17C.60.230K). "Pierce County and all its employees" to be listed as an additional insured
- Washington State fireworks stand permit (contact State Fire Marshal*) Fill out completely and sign
- Stand permit fee = \$100.00
- Clean up bond fee = \$250.00
 - (separate checks, please)
- Shall provide 24 hour emergency contact name and telephone number
- Fireworks stands shall be in accordance with WAC 212-17, RCW 70.77 and Pierce County Code 17C.60
- Permission of property owner is required. Applicant shall provide a current letter of authorization from the property owner stating the stand location is approved
- Tent security plan (if applicable)
- Tent certificate of flammability
- Stand removal and clean up shall be completed prior to July 16th

Applications for permits for the 4th of July fireworks season will be accepted by the Fire Marshal only during the period between March 15 and May 10 of the year for which the permit is sought. The number of permits available is limited (refer to PC Code 17C.60.090). Pierce County Zoning restrictions may apply. Last day to submit application is May 10th. Fire Prevention Bureau inspection of stand required.

NOTE: In the event of a burn ban, restrictions may apply.

NOTE: Sale and purchase of fireworks December 27 through December 31 are prohibited in unincorporated Pierce County.
