SUMMARY OF REQUIREMENTS TO OBTAIN A FIREWORKS PERMIT

PYROTECHNIC SPECIAL EFFECTS (FBPT)

SUBMITTALS REQUIRED:

- Completed permit application
- Detailed site plan and/or floor plan
- Quantities
- Type of fireworks
- Copy of current Washington State Pyrotechnician's license
- Permit fee = \$275.00
- Pyrotechnics shall be in accordance with WAC 212-17, RCW 70.77, Pierce County Code 17C.60, and International Fire Code Section 3301

Pyrotechnic special effects shall be conducted by a Washington State licensed pyrotechnician. Please allow at least 15 working days prior to event for PC Fire Prevention plan review and approval of permit application. Fire Prevention Bureau inspection may be required.

NOTE: In the event of a burn ban, restrictions may apply.

NOTE: Sale and purchase of fireworks December 27 through December 31 are prohibited in unincorporated Pierce County.
