- *Space is limited, there is a lottery drawing for available surgery spaces.
Lottery ticket(s) distribution is from 7:15am to 7:30am. Lottery tickets are given out per animal.
Only 3 animals per household per day are allowed. Only 3 animals per household in any 3-month period.
Drawing for surgery spaces begins at 7:30 am.
A Washington driver's license or state issued ID is required.
We DO NOT operate on a first-come, first-served basis.
- * Spay or neuter surgery is free for pets of those individuals on public assistance: Proof of participation in a state or federal public assistance program (not Medicare) is required.
For those not on public assistance: Cat spays \$30; Cat neuters \$20; Dog spays \$55; Dog neuters \$45; No Micro-chipping on this day. We provide low-cost vaccinations and flea treatments for \$10 each for pets that are in the clinic for surgery. **We accept CASH ONLY.**
- * Dogs must be at least four (4) months of age. Kittens must weigh at least 3 pounds.
- * For dogs 8 years and older, we must have a blood work-up by your veterinarian prior to clinic surgery and we must have that report. Our vet staff has the right to turn away your pet for any medical, health or behavioral issue. Pregnant or in-heat animals can be brought for surgery.
- * We cannot accommodate large dogs, aggressive dogs, or dogs over 50 pounds.
- ***Steps to prepare your pet for surgery:**
Do not give your adult animal any food or water after 10 PM the night before surgery. Failure to follow this can put your pet at risk during surgery.
Do give four-month old puppies or kittens food and water, up to half their usual amount, the morning of surgery.
For the safety of your pets:
Dogs **MUST BE** on a well-fitted collar and leash or in a carrier
Cats **MUST BE** confined in a carrier or pillowcase. Cats **MUST** stay in carrier or pillowcase while in parking lot.
ONLY (1) CAT PER CARRIER OR PILLOWCASE!
Large bath towel donations are greatly appreciated!
Escape from well-fitted collar or carrier can put your pet at serious risk.
- ***Animals must be picked up the same day as surgery.** The Veterinary Technician or Coordinator will assign you your animal pick-up time when you drop off your pet in the morning.
