

### **AMENDMENT 3 to FY 2004**

1. Activity No. 28, Lutheran Community Services, Domestic Violence Family Center. Cancel, decrease funds to \$0.00.

### **AMENDMENT 1 to FY 2005**

1. Activity No. 43, CDBG Administration. Transfer administration dollars in the amount of \$145,000 to program services for FY 2009.

### **AMENDMENT 1 to FY 2006**

1. Activity No. 1, Network Tacoma, Community Auto Repair Garage. Cancel, decrease funds from \$75,000 to \$0.00.
2. Activity No. 34, Pierce County Community Development Corporation, Community Housing Development Organizations. Project Funded: Multi Service Center funded in the amount of \$212,800.20 for the Hawthorne Lane project (32 units of permanent rental housing).

### **AMENDMENT 2 to FY 2007**

1. Activity No. 10, GATEWAYS For Youth and Families, Education Visitation & Safe Exchange. Cancel, decrease funding from \$10,901.00 to \$0.00.
2. Activity No. 12, Helping Hand House, Emergency Housing Program. All funding for this program in the amount of \$27,400 will be for ESG Essential Services. Decrease Homeless Prevention funds of \$9,086 to 0.00 and transfer to ESG Essential Services. Agency already had \$18,314 allocated for the use of ESG Essential Services. Scope of work does not change.
3. Activity No. 14, MLK Housing Development Association, Men's & Women's Overnight Shelter. Decrease ESG Homeless Prevention funds from \$4,228 to \$0.00. Decrease ESG Maintenance & Operation funds from \$19,420.00 to \$12,982.50.
4. Activity No. 17, Shared Housing Services, Shared Housing – Pierce County. Transfer funds in the amount of \$3,080 of the \$15,000 ESG Essential Services to ESG Homeless Prevention funds. Amount and scope of work do not change. Total equals \$3,080 of ESG Homeless Prevention dollars and \$11,920 of ESG Essential Services for a total of \$15,000.
5. Activity No. 25, Eatonville Area Council, Eatonville Area Wellness Center & Sr. Housing. Cancel, decrease CDBG funding from \$100,000 to \$0.00.

6. Activity No. 27, Oakridge Manor Neighborhood Watch, 2 New Street Lights. Cancel, decrease funds from \$3,454.00 to \$0.00.

7. Add Project, Activity No. 42, Associated Ministries, Inclement Weather. Funded with \$10,000 of CDBG public service dollars. Scope of work: Funds to be used for motel vouchers for homeless families and/or individuals.

8. Activity No. 39, Pierce County Community Development Corporation, Community Housing Development Organizations. Project Funded: Multi Service Center funded in the amount of \$537,140 for the Hawthorne Lane project (32 units of permanent rental housing).

### **AMENDMENT 1 to FY 2008**

1. Activity No. 9, Indochinese Cultural and Service Center, Southeast Asian Domestic Violence Project. The Indochinese Cultural and Service Center merged with the Koreans Women's Association (KWA). KWA will now be the agency carrying out this program. Scope of work will not change.

2. Activity No. 11; (HUD activity #1929), Korean Women's Association, Asian Pacific Senior Daycare. Change program from Asian Pacific Senior Daycare to We Are Family. Scope of work changes from providing specialized adult day care services to Asian Pacific senior citizens, to provide shelter for domestic violence victims that serves Asian Pacific Islander immigrant/refugee women who need culturally relevant services that will create a safe environment for them. Project funded with \$1450 of ESG Maintenance & Operations dollars.

3. Activity No. 11; (HUD activity #1905), Korean Women's Association, Asian Pacific Senior Daycare. Increase CDBG amount from \$9,677 to \$9,680.00. Change of scope does not change.

4. Activity No. 11; (HUD activity #1899), Korean Women's Association, Asian Pacific Senior Daycare. Change program from Asian Pacific Senior Daycare to We Are Family. Scope of work changes from providing specialized adult day care services to Asian Pacific senior citizens, to provide shelter for domestic violence victims that serves Asian Pacific Islander immigrant/refugee women who need culturally relevant services that will create a safe environment for them. Project funded with \$8870 of ESG Maintenance & Operations dollars.

5. Activity No. 19, TACID, HELP program. Increase ESG Homeless Prevention dollars from \$3,004.50 to \$7,232.50. TACID was also funded with \$11,995.50 of ESG Essential Services funds.

6. Activity No. 30, Tacoma Goodwill Industries, Work Opportunity Center. Change scope from, construct telecommunications infrastructure for new 63,000 sq. foot facility,

to, construct a parking lot across the street from the work opportunity center. Parking lot is for clients who are using the work center.

7. Activity No. 38, CDBG Administration. Decrease funding from \$658,860 to \$589,740.

8. Add Project, Activity No. 41, Associated Ministries, Inclement Weather. Funded with \$10,000 of CDBG public service dollars. Scope of work: Funds to be used for motel vouchers for homeless families and/or individuals.

9. Add Project, Activity No. 42, Fair Housing Center of WA, Housing Assistance. Funded with \$30,000 of CDBG public service dollars. Scope of work: To conduct 30 fair housing tests and 13 training sessions.
