The following technical amendments to Exhibit B in proposed Ordinance 2009 - 71 would insert the date of the Final Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement, the dates of the Community Development Committee and Council meetings and the effective date of the Ordinance.

1. On page 2 of the Ordinance, line 26, insert "September 18, 2009" in the blank to show as follows:

**Whereas**, on September 18, 2009, the Environmental Official for Pierce County issued a Final Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement for all the various proposed amendments to the Comprehensive Plan; and

2. On page 3 of the Ordinance, line 3, insert September 21 in the blank to show as follows:

**Whereas**, on August 31 and September 21, 2009, the Community Development Committee held public hearing on the Planning Commission's final recommendations, and on September 21, 2009, passed the Committee's recommendations on the text amendments, area-wide map amendments, urban growth area amendments, and community plan amendments to the full Council for further consideration; and

3. On page 3 of the Ordinance, line 7, insert October 13 in the blank to show as follows:

**Whereas**, on October 13, 2009, the Pierce County Council held a public hearing on the proposed amendments to Pierce County's Comprehensive Plan and considered the amendments concurrently so their cumulative effect and consistency could be ascertained; and

4. On page 4 of the Ordinance, line 14, insert May 1 in the blank to show as follows:

Section 9. This Ordinance shall become effective on May 1, 2010.
