

# ALERT

The Trench work is finally completed at the entrance to the ambulance drop-off at Madigan's Emergency Department.

However, Jackson Ave and the <sup>New</sup> northbound Berkeley I-5 ramp are now under construction. Please see the following messages for details, how they affect emergency vehicle traffic and a map of the detours.

# ALERT

JBLM Public Works will be repaving Jackson Avenue starting this Monday, July 25 and last until August 15. The work will consist of grinding out the old pavement, some road improvements and then paving will be done in the evening hours between 1900 and 0500.

During the work hours of 1900 to 0500, Jackson Avenue will be totally closed from Gardner Loop Road to Hillside Drive.

Traffic inbound from Madigan Gate can access Gardner Loop while the construction is in progress. Traffic coming northbound on Jackson Avenue will be diverted through Hillside Avenue to Blaine Avenue to 5th Street and then Gardner Loop Road. During the hours of work, access to the Madigan Medical Mall Parking will be through the Pharmacy Drive Thru, but the Hospital Tower Parking Lot will have no access.

During the day from 0500 to 1900, Jackson Avenue will have a single lane open between Gardner Loop Road and Hillside Avenue.

Obviously this long overdue repaving project will impact us and our patients, but will since JBLM Public Works has established this reverse cycle work schedule, the impacts during the day will be minimal.

Please find attached the detour route map and thank you in advance for your patience.

## **Scott Stephen of Madigan Ambulance adds the following for EMS traffic:**

Traffic inbound from Madigan Gate can access Gardner Loop while the construction is in progress. Take Gardner loop (the first right at the light) to the entrance of the emergency room.

Getting off post they may have to take the main gate exit.

### **In addition:**

The Northbound Berkeley Ave I-5 ramp closed to traffic after 2200-2300 for the next several days combined with the I-5 traffic AND the Jackson Avenue construction - northbound ambulances coming up to JBLM may not be able to get off at the MAMC I-5 ramp - and have to go through a prolonged detour through residential sections (20 MPH speed limit) of JBLM from the Main Gate.

North bound ambulance should use the main gate until the Berkeley ramps have been repaired. If they pass the main gate then they will have to us thorn lane to turn around.
