Skagit Eagle Watch

Nature's splendor as few have seen it. Each winter, up to 300 Bald Eagles congregate in the Skagit Preserve. These magnificent and endangered birds are accustomed to seeing only the occasional river boat in their protected habitat, so sightings are frequent. With wingspans up to seven feet, the eagle is truly majestic at close range.

You'll float calmly and comfortably with other enthusiasts in astoundingly beautiful scenery, watching our National Symbol feeding on the banks, soaring above or perched only a few yards away. Guides are experience eagle watchers. Trip includes all rafting equipment.

The Legislative Building is the crowning piece of the Washington State Capitol Campus. Completed in 1928, it boasts one of the tallest free standing masonry domes in the world and houses the largest chandelier ever made by the Tiffany Lighting Company. The one-hour tour of the Legislative Building includes the North Foyer, Rotunda, State Reception Room, and Legislative Galleries.

The Veterans Memorial includes the Winged Victory, POW-MIA, Medal of Honor, Vietnam Veterans, WW II, and Korean War Memorials. Self-Guided memorial brochures are available at the Visitor Information Desk and at the Legislative Building Tour Information Desk.
