Discover pure links golf while immersing yourself in panoramic views of the Puget Sound and Olympic Mountains. As the site of the 2010 U.S. Amateur and the 2015 U.S. Open, Chambers Bay was designed to challenge the greatest players in the world. Yet it's a course that anyone can play. Inspired by the open landscape and spectacular location, renowned architect Robert Trent Jones II remained true to links tradition by creating a unique and authentic waterfront course which provides a premium public golf experience. And as the first course in the Pacific Northwest to earn the Audubon Society's coveted International Silver Signature Sanctuary designation, Chambers Bay is creating a new tradition of managing and protecting water quality and wildlife habitat for the betterment of the environment and the future of the game.



Chambers Bay was conceived to be a championship course that anyone can play. With towering sand dunes, massive fairways and contoured greens, it provides a true connection to the birthplace of the game. A par 72, walking-only course, Chambers Bay stretches from 5,100 to 7,585 yards on fescue turf from tee to green. Experienced, knowledgeable caddies are available to carry your bag and lower your score with their advice. A practice facility offers players the chance to improve their skills at the driving range and short game area. A staff of PGA Professionals is available for instruction and private lessons.

Suggested caddie bag fees for caddies participating in the Chambers Bay caddie program are \$50/single bag, \$100/double bag and \$60 for a forecaddie. Bag fees and gratuities are paid directly to the caddie. The amount of any gratuity is determined at the sole discretion of the guest.

Learn to Golf Program at Lake Spanaway Golf Course

This is a year round program offered by Pierce County Parks and Recreation in conjunction with Premier Golf. The Learn to Golf Program will guide juniors through the introduction of the game to learning the skills necessary to enjoy the game for a lifetime or compete at any level, if so desired.

Juniors that are new to the program but not new to the game do not need to start at the beginner level to benefit from this program. Any junior may contact the Golf Professionals at Lake Spanaway and schedule a skills test to determine their position in the program. The skills test to pass into a level is universal. Any junior may set up an appointment during the year to be evaluated.

Beginner Levels:

Class instruction will be structured for first timers to learn fundamentals, proper technique, rules of the game, and much more. Beginner Level students will be provided with clubs if they do not have their own.

- Level 1 - Putter & 7 Iron
- Level 2 - 5 Iron and 5 Wood
- Level 3 - 9 Iron and 3 Wood

Each level will teach the skills necessary for using each club in both full swing and short game settings. Upon completion of the Beginner Level 3, juniors will be ready to advance to Intermediate Levels.
