What's happening

The Cascadia Development Corporation and Pierce County are improving 2½ miles of 198th Avenue East between 144th Street East and 104th Street East. The project will be built in phases to provide improvements required of the Cascadia development and also accommodate future widening by Pierce County.

The initial, or Phase 1 project will:

- Construct the roadway - 2 to 3 lanes between 104th Street and 120th Street East and 4 to 5 lanes between 120th Street and 144th Street East.
- Construct traffic signals at 104th Street, Rhodes Lake Road and 120th Street East.

Future phases depending on traffic growth will:

- Widen the roadway - to 5 lanes between 104th Street and 144th Street East.
