**RESOLUTION NO. R2001-80**

A RESOLUTION OF THE PIERCE COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING ITS INTENTION AND THE NECESSITY TO ESTABLISH AN ALIGNMENT FOR A NEW COUNTY ROAD IN THE VICINITY OF RHODES LAKE ROAD EAST FROM SR-162 TO 198<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE EAST, LOCATED IN THE VICINITY OF THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF BONNEY LAKE; AND DIRECTING THE COUNTY ENGINEER TO REPORT UPON SUCH PROJECT.

WHEREAS, The Pierce County Council finds that it is a public necessity that an alignment for a new County road be established and constructed in the vicinity of Rhodes Lake Road East from SR-162 to 198<sup>th</sup> Avenue East to ease traffic congestion and provide for an adequate, efficient, and safe roadway for public use; and

WHEREAS, Revised Code of Washington 36.81.010 provides that the Pierce County Council may, by original Resolution, declare its intention to establish a new County road and declare that it is a public necessity; NOW, THEREFORE,
