

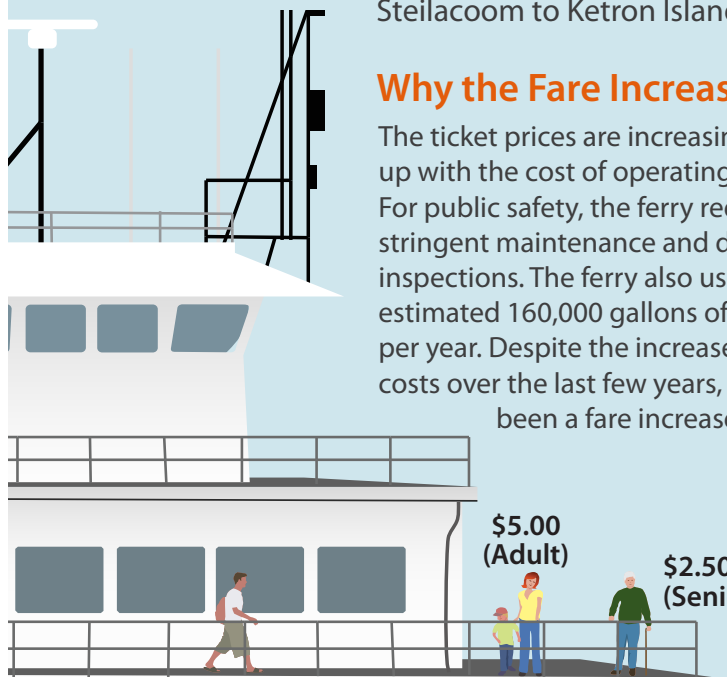
Ferry Fare Increases and Service Changes

Effective Jan. 1, 2012

- **Ticket Prices will be increased.** No refunds will be issued after Feb. 15, 2012 for tickets purchased prior to the change.
- Senior and Disabled Citizens **must** show their ID at boarding when using a discount ticket.
- **Exempt Passenger/Vehicle category is eliminated.** Tickets will need to be purchased prior to boarding.
- For service departing from **Ketron Island**, you must make a reservation at least 20 minutes in advance by calling **(253) 588-1950**.
- The first Sunday ferry run will leave at 6:45 a.m. from Steilacoom to Ketron Island.

Why the Fare Increase?

The ticket prices are increasing to keep up with the cost of operating the ferry. For public safety, the ferry requires stringent maintenance and drydock inspections. The ferry also uses an estimated 160,000 gallons of diesel fuel per year. Despite the increase in fuel costs over the last few years, there hasn't been a fare increase since 2008.
