Schedule and Fares

Effective January 1, 2008

Anderson and Ketron Islands



Vehicles:

- When approaching the loading lanes, first fill the left lane (Lane 1), then the center lane (Lane 2), then the right lane (Lane 3). Loading will take place in the same order.
- Purchase the correct ticket(s) at the waiting facility.
- Don't park on the Steilacoom dock to purchase your tickets unless you have a disabled parking permit.
- Turn off cell phones and follow directions from crew members when loading or unloading.
- Stay in the lanes and drive 5 MPH or slower with your lights off.
- At night, use parking lights only.
- Be cautious of ferry employees and others on the car deck.
- Pull as close as you can to the vehicle in front of you, set the parking brake, turn the engine off, and wait until traffic around you and in adjacent lanes has stopped before opening your vehicle doors.

Walk-on Passengers

- Walk-on passengers must wait in the designated waiting areas until directed to go aboard or go ashore by the ferry crew.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Vehicles, drivers, and passengers must be in line at least 20 minutes before departure time or they may not be allowed to board the ferry.

1. Vehicle fare includes driver. Each additional person in the car must pay the applicable walk-on fare.
2. Senior citizens (age 65+), must show valid photo ID or a Regional Reduced Fare permit. Disabled passengers must show valid disability ID at the time of boarding (Regional Reduced Fare permit, or VA of 40% disability level, or ADA paratransit card, or Medicare card).
3. Commuter tickets are valid for 40 days from date of purchase until the expiration date indicated on each ticket. They may be used by only one person per vehicle per trip and may not be used for other vehicles or persons waiting to board the ferry. NO REFUNDS for unused tickets.
4. Vehicle length is measured from the furthest protruding item at the front and/or top of the vehicle to the furthest protruding item at the rear and/or top of the vehicle and/or trailer.
5. Large carry-on items including kayaks, canoes and other items of comparable size shall be charged at the motorcycle rate and includes the fare for the walk-on passenger carrying the item to be stowed.
6. All governmental and/or public institutional passengers and vehicles with a tax-exempt license plate, and the occupants, will be provided free passage when conducting official governmental or public institutional business on the islands.
7. Vehicles 80 feet or longer, or over 11 feet in width, must schedule their departure time in advance by calling (253) 588-1950.
8. A 3-wheel vehicle is any motorcycle with a trailer or sidecar or any vehicle licensed as a motorcycle with three or more wheels.

Cash (U.S. Currency), money orders, travelers checks, King County Metro Commuter Bonus Voucher, and credit cards (Visa or MasterCard only) are accepted.

Full service ticketing is available at the Steilacoom Waiting Facility. Ticket purchase by credit/debit card (Visa or MasterCard only) at the Anderson Island Store kiosk or at www.piercecountywa.org/ferry.

From Seattle:

- From southbound Interstate-5 take Exit 125 onto Bridgeport Way.
- Follow Bridgeport Way and turn left onto Steilacoom Boulevard.
- Turn right onto Puyallup Street.
- Turn left onto Rainier Street.
- Turn right onto Union Avenue.
- Follow Union Avenue to the ferry landing.

From Olympia:

- From northbound Interstate-5 take Exit 119 (DuPont/Steilacoom).
- Turn left and cross over the freeway and proceed past the railroad tracks.
- Turn right onto Steilacoom-DuPont Road SW.
- Steilacoom-DuPont Road becomes Union Avenue.
- Follow Union Avenue to the ferry landing.
