Application Schedule

Lawns
Apply 20 lbs of SoundGRO® per 1000 sq ft four times per year.

Cool-Season Grasses
mid-March
mid-May
early September
late October

Shrubs
Spread 4 lbs of SoundGRO® per 100 sq ft on shrub bed.

Trees
Apply 5 lbs of SoundGRO® for every inch of the tree's diameter measured four feet from the ground. Apply under drip line or outer circumference of tree.

Annuals
Mix 3 lbs of SoundGRO® per 100 sq ft into flower bed soil during the spring. Repeat when buds are forming.

Perennials & Vegetable Gardens
Mix 5 lbs of SoundGRO® per 100 sq ft into flower bed during the spring. Repeat when buds are forming.
