10 **A Resolution of the Pierce County Council Creating an Ad Hoc Citizens**
11 **Advisory Committee to Evaluate and Provide**
12 **Recommendations to Pierce County Regarding Channel**
13 **Migration Zones; Appointing Members; and Setting a Sunset**
14 **Date.**

16 **Whereas**, considerable public interest has been generated regarding Pierce
17 County policy as it relates to Channel Migration Zones; and

18
19 **Whereas**, by Resolution No. R2008-55 the Pierce County Council expressed its
20 intent to establish an ad hoc advisory committee to evaluate and provide
21 recommendations regarding County policy as it relates to Channel Migration Zones; and

22
23 **Whereas**, the Resolution states that the ad hoc advisory committee is to be
24 comprised of a variety of stakeholders including affected property owners, floodplain
25 management professionals, and members of local watershed councils; and

26
27 **Whereas**, the Council's intent was to delay new legislation regarding the
28 adoption of new Channel Migration Zone studies (including the adoption of maps) in
29 order to provide sufficient time for the ad hoc advisory group to evaluate the issue and
30 provide recommendations; and

32 **Whereas**, the Council, by Resolution No. R2008-55, also asked the Executive to
33 forward a list of recommended appointees to the ad hoc advisory committee composed
34 of interested parties solicited through media and various stakeholder groups; and

36 **Whereas**, the Executive has forwarded a list of recommended appointees as
37 requested by Resolution No. R2008-55; **Now Therefore**,

39 **BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Pierce County:**

1 Section 1. The Council hereby creates the Pierce County Citizens' Advisory
2 Committee on Channel Migration Zones. This ad hoc advisory committee is requested
3 to evaluate and provide recommendations regarding the regulation of Channel Migration
4 Zones including, but not limited to, the process for mapping such areas, development
5 standards that should apply to such areas, process for notifying property owners of
6 potential natural hazards associated with such areas, and related matters.


