Pierce County Public Works and Utilities Water Programs Division cordially invite you to attend the public meeting to learn more about the County's intent to apply for Federal and State funding through the FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant Program which is administered by Washington State's Emergency Management Division.

The natural hazard which the application intends to address is flood damaged properties due to river flooding in November 2006. The proposed application will utilize the County's adopted All Hazards Mitigation Plan and the Puyallup River Basin Comprehensive Flood Control Management Plan recommendations. The plans contain adopted mitigation strategies which guides how the County responds flood events in order to reduce flood damages to people and their property.

Pierce County Local funds will be used as a match if the proposed project application is approved.
