Notice of Public Meetings

Pierce County Public Works and Utilities Water Programs Division will hold two public open house meetings on the Carbon River and Upper Puyallup River Basin Characterization as follows: August 27, 2007 from 3:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at the South Prairie Community Center, 304 SR-162, South Prairie; and August 28, 2007 from 3:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at the Kapowsin Grange, 14810 Kapowsin Highway East, Graham. The characterization describes existing conditions and problems bearing on storm drainage and surface water management in areas draining to the Carbon River and Upper Puyallup River. It concludes Phase 1 of an update of the 1991 Pierce County Storm Drainage and Surface Water Management Plan that will be known as the Carbon River and Upper Puyallup River Basin Plan. Basin plans provide Water Programs direction for surface water management activities and capital improvements in the study area. Interested people are invited to meet with staff, review findings, ask questions, and comment on the characterization.
