

Request for Salmon Habitat Protection and Restoration Project Proposals

The Pierce County (WRIA 10/12) Lead Entity is soliciting project proposals for salmon habitat protection and restoration projects in the Puyallup/White River and Chambers/Clover Creek watersheds. Project proposals will be evaluated, ranked, and submitted on September 1, 2009 to the Washington State Salmon Recovery Funding Board (SRFB) and Puget Sound Partnership (PSP) for funding consideration. It is expected that submitted projects will be consistent with the WRIA 10/12 three-year work plan (project list) and the lead entity strategy.

Eligible applicants for SRFB and PSP funding include cities, counties, conservation districts, Indian Tribes, non-profit organizations, special purpose districts, and private landowners. Private landowners are eligible applicants for restoration projects only when the project takes place on their own land.
