LAND USE ADVISORY COMMISSIONS

Training for new LUAC members has been scheduled for August 18, 2009, at 6:00 p.m., at the Pierce County Annex in the Public Hearing Room. The program is focused for new members; however, the information will be a great refresher for the general membership.

The LUACs have been busy with many items coming before them for their input. Advance Planning has taken the Comprehensive Plan Update before the members of the individual Commissions for their review and recommendations. Also, Phase I of the Code Consolidation Project was presented to the LUAC Chairpersons, which is a bit different in how we present changes in the regulations. The meeting went well and everyone had their input.

PERFORMANCE OF REVIEW FOR JUNE 2009

The backlog for Current Planning for June was 69. This figure is lower than May, but still not at the goal of 95%. The efficiency percentage of reviews done on time was 60.4%. However, with the reduction of staff, we have maintained the backlog under 100.

The number of reviews for June 2009 increased to 253 from the May figure of 201. The application types that increased in June were Time Extensions, Residential Building Permits, and general land use applications. The decreases in application types were shoreline exemptions and commercial building permits.
