TITLE: **ALCOHOLICS ANONYMOUS REPRESENTATIVE
DRUG AND ALCOHOL SERVICES - DETENTION**

JOB SUMMARY: Coordinate an Alcoholics Anonymous meeting once per week for Remann Hall residents.

JOB DUTIES: Encourage youth to voluntarily attend AA meetings.
Develop an atmosphere of familiarity with the AA Program.
Explain the AA Program to youth and how to utilize it to sustain abstinence.
Provide an opportunity for youth to make beneficial contacts with other youth involved in AA.

**TRAINING,
EDUCATION
EXPERIENCE:** A minimum of one year of sobriety.
Must be a member of Alcoholics Anonymous.
Attendance at a half-day Cultural Diversity Training required.

**PERSONAL
TRAITS:** Must exercise a wide latitude for mature decision-making.

REQUIREMENTS: Must be 20 years old or older.
Must have a genuine concern for drug and alcohol-related youth.
Must submit to a background check.

**JOB
RELATIONSHIPS:** Supervised by a Chemical Dependency Specialist.
Responsible to the Volunteer Services Manager.

**TIME
COMMITMENT:** A one-hour session once a week for six months.
