

JOB DESCRIPTION

TITLE:	BEAUTICIAN/HAIRDRESSER DETENTION SERVICES
JOB SUMMARY:	Assist children in improving their self-image through personal appearance and grooming.
JOB DUTIES:	Set up, operating, and close the beauty shop facilities. Account for all equipment used, especially potentially harmful items such as razors, scissors, nail files and tweezers. Supervise youth while performing various personal grooming activities such as shampooing, shaving, and cutting of children's hair (depending on the volunteer's experience and/or qualifications).
TRAINING, EDUCATION EXPERIENCE:	Training as a barber, beautician or cosmetologist is helpful but not required. Attendance at a half-day Cultural Diversity Training required.
PERSONAL TRAITS:	A person should possess patience, empathy and relate well with juveniles. Must be aware of the safety precautions needed due to the type of equipment used. Ability to supervise youth's behavior according to beauty shop and detention rules.
REQUIREMENTS:	Must be 18 years old or older. Must submit to a background check.
JOB:	Supervised by a Cosmetology Instructor and the Assistant Detention Administrator. Responsible to the Volunteer Services Manager.
