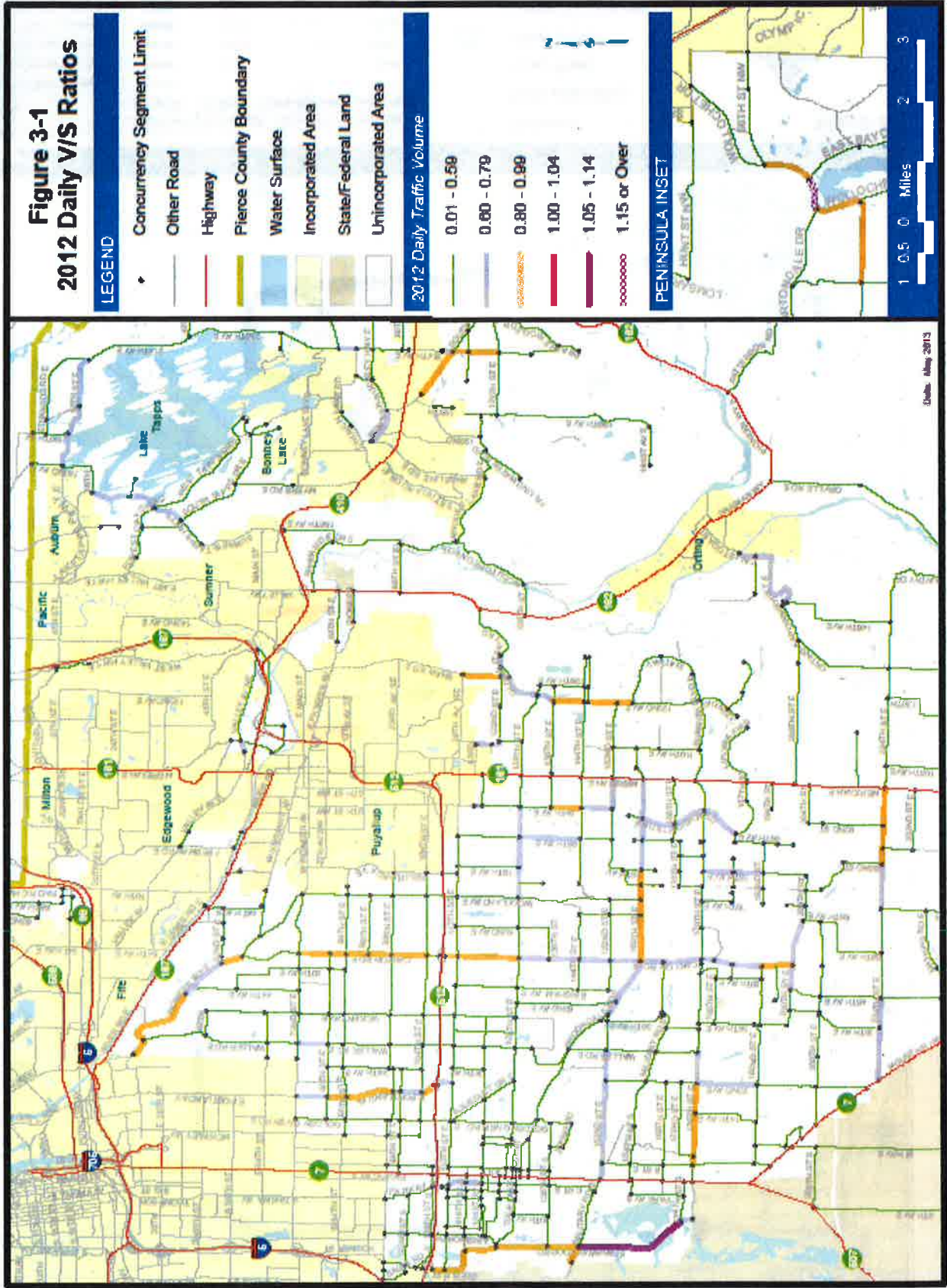

MOPIA encapsulates the five major activity areas of the Office of the County Engineer:

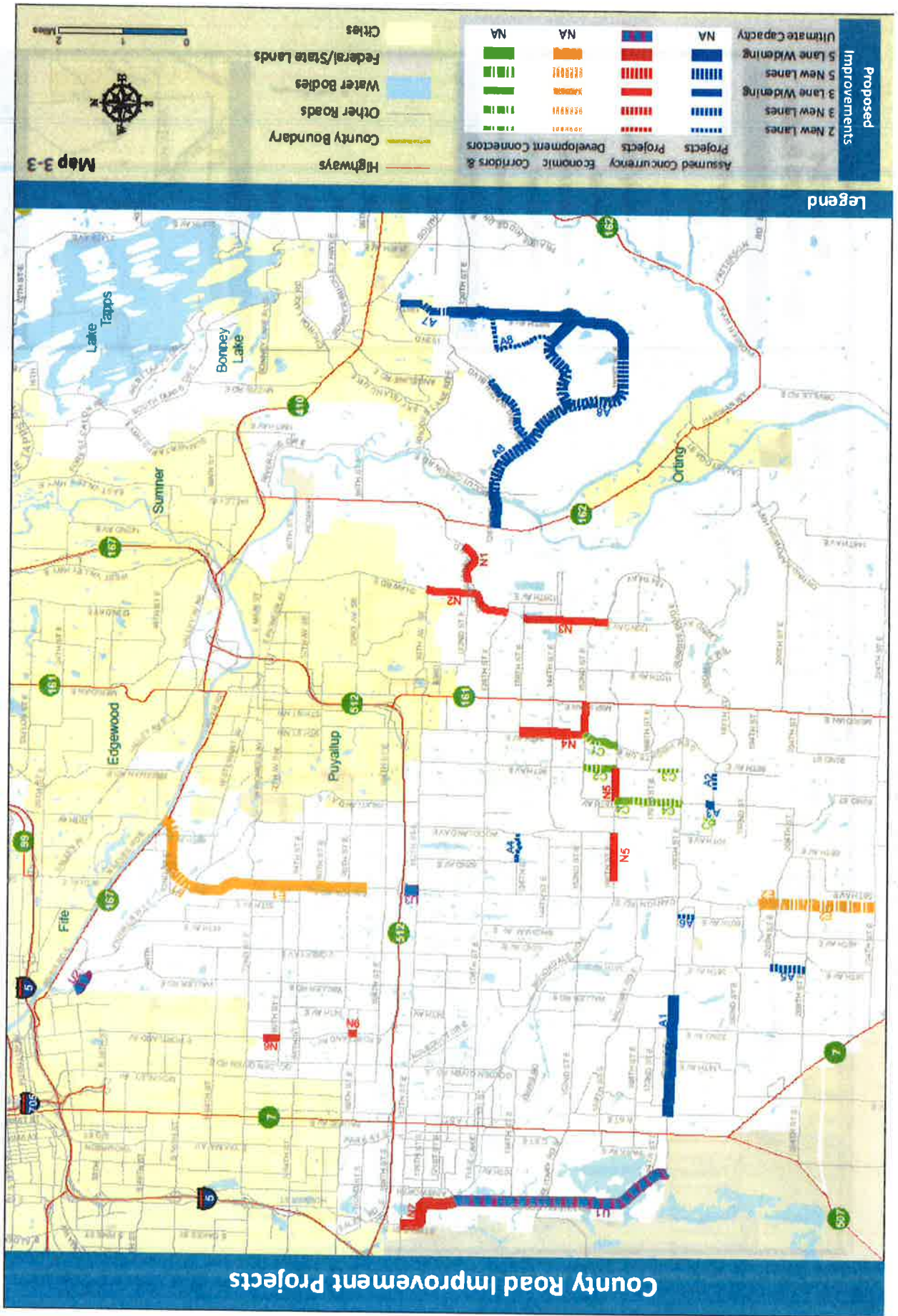
- Maintenance – Maintaining existing systems - repairing potholes, damaged pavement and sidewalks, vegetation control, pavement markings
- Operations – operating the system – street sweeping, snow removal paying for fuel and power
- Preservation – Replacement or major repair – repaving, replacing bridges and electrical systems
- Improvements – major improvements such as new and widened roads and traffic signals
- Administration – Staff and physical space needed to plan, engineer, operate, and maintain the system

Maintenance, Operations, and Preservation take priority over Improvements

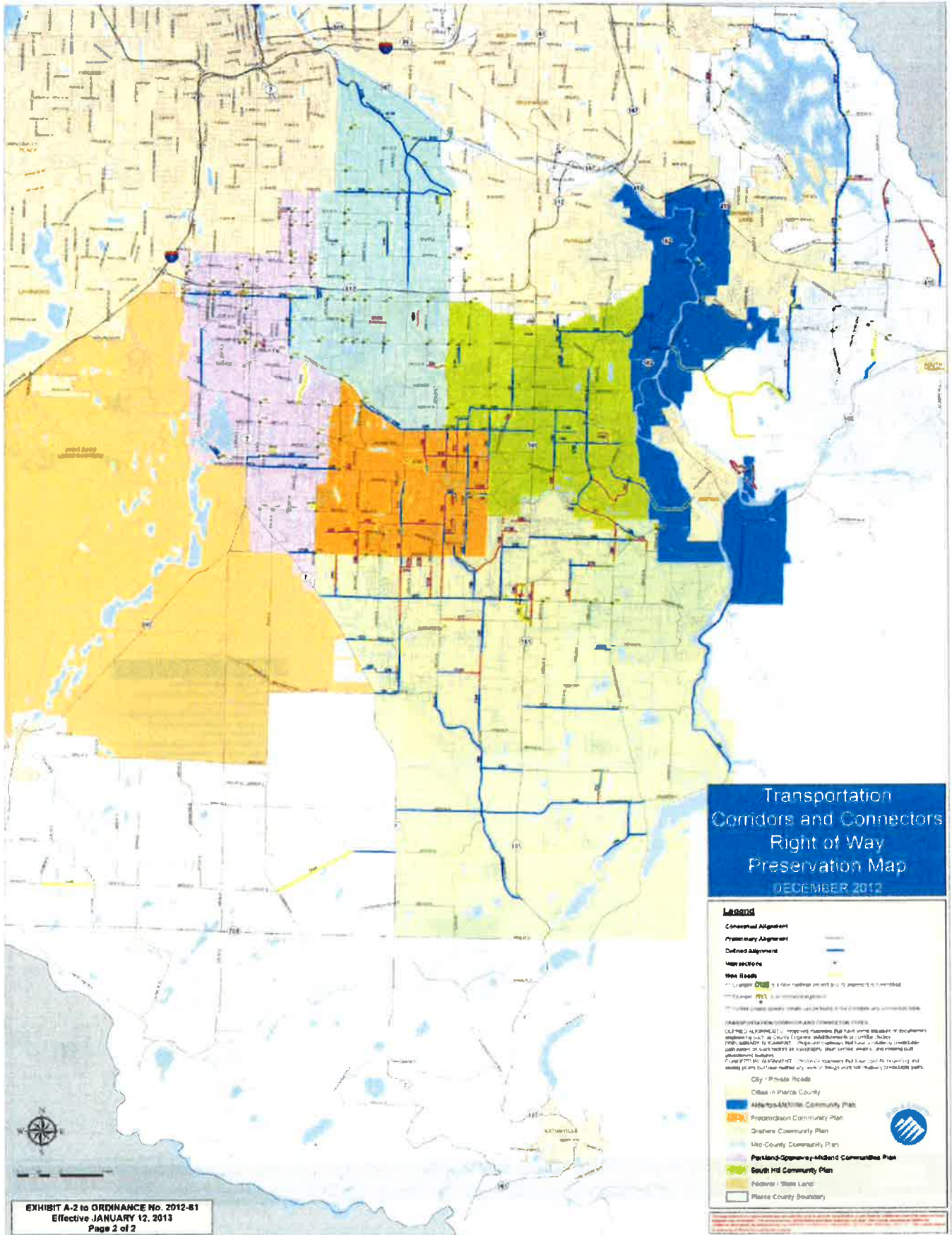
