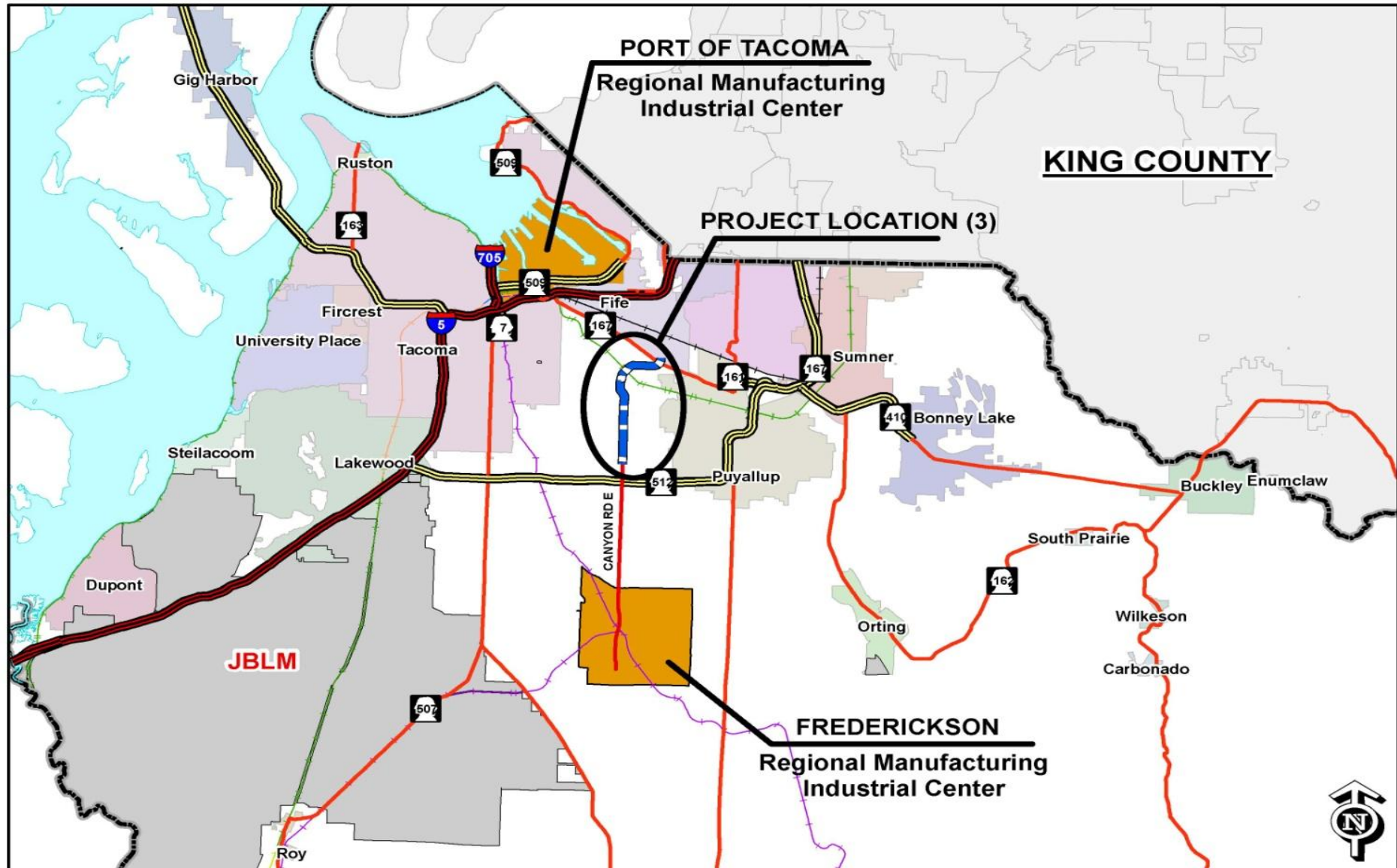

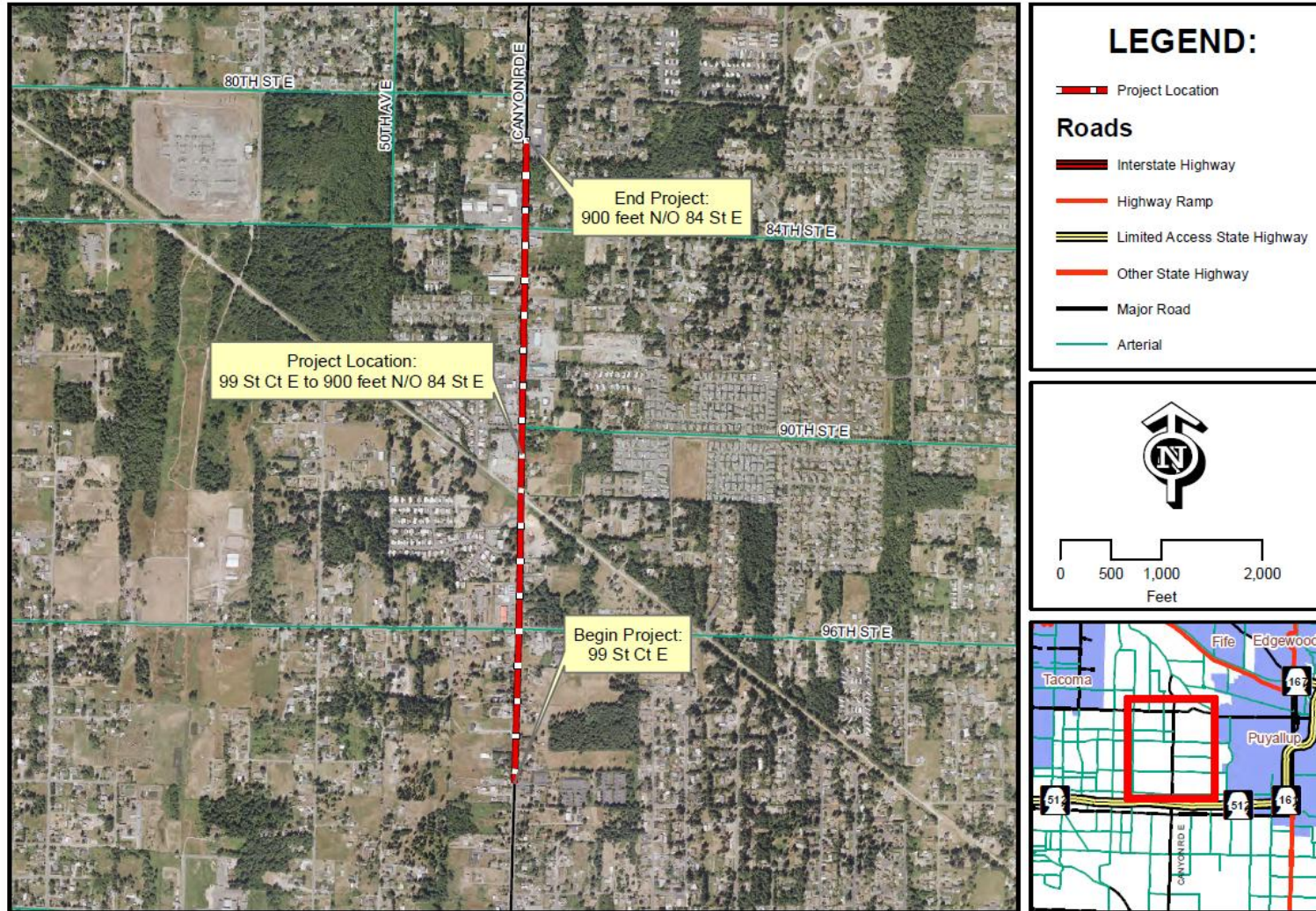
General Projects Location



Why Improve the Corridor?

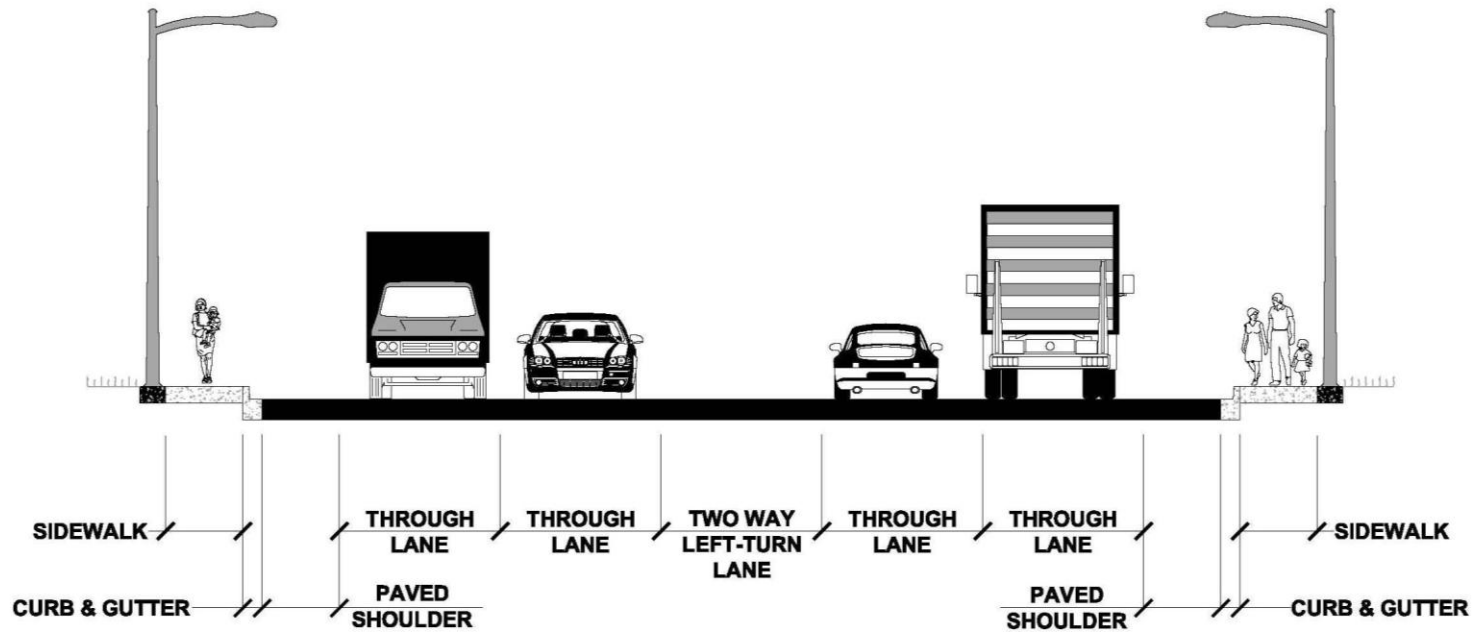
- Failed concurrency in 2005
- Increase capacity
- Reduce congestion and greenhouse gas emissions
- Enhance opportunities for economic growth
 - Retains and expands family wage jobs
 - Reduces costs of conducting business
 - Supports global gateway shipping

Project Vicinity Map



- Improve transportation capacity
 - Add through lanes
 - Add two-way left-turn lane
 - Signalize Canyon Rd E/96th St E intersection
 - Upgrade signal at Canyon Rd E/84th St E intersection
- Improve safety
 - Add street lighting
 - Add pedestrian and bicycle facilities

Canyon Road East
96th Street East to 84th Street East

- Finalize Preliminary Engineering Phase and ROW plans in **2012**
- Environmental permitting complete in **2014**
- Currently requesting grant funds to begin ROW Phase in **2014**
- Construction start anticipated in **2018**, contingent on funding availability
- Construction completion anticipated in **2020**
