1. Presenter-JBLM FD, Chris Barnard

The issue on JBLM for presentation and discussion: Calling the Base Station for determination of death. Termination of resuscitation/withholding CPR versus time of death. Audio files of two different situations were played; discussion followed regarding the challenges faced:

- Making the call of death.
- When to make the call.
- When or when not to transport.

Other input: AHA Guidelines say we are not spending enough time with CPR.

Discussion about reporting time of death to Base Station and how ME wants a time stamp.

Norma suggests we work with ME to determine the policy.

B. Standing Updates

1. Stroke Update

- **Franciscan Health System**

Sue – Passed out the date sheet from St. Joseph's; pre-notification dropped to 70% but stayed the same at St. Anthony's and St. Clare's.

- **MultiCare Health System**

Overall, 25% of stroke patients are transferred from other hospitals. We are doing well dealing with stroke patients.

2. Cardiac Update

- **MultiCare Health System**

Had no representative to report, but send a slide of data that was presented and read by Cynde.

- **Franciscan Health System**

Data examples were presented from the STEMI Feedback Data Form. Asked if sending the forms is helpful, even if they are incomplete. Consensus was, "YES!"
