Special Election - Proposition No. 1

Six-Year Levy Lid Lift for Advanced Life Support Services

DuPont City Council adopted ordinance 17-1018 affecting the City's regular property tax rate. Proposition 1 would provide ALS services at no out of pocket cost to residents for necessary use and increase fire and EMS crew from three to five. Regular property tax levy would increase by \$1.52 per \$1,000 assessed value replacing the existing EMS levy of \$.50: a net increase of \$1.02 per \$1,000. Should this proposition be:
