



## CONDITIONS FOR ALCOHOL ON PREMISES

Events wishing to serve alcohol may do so only if the alcohol is served by a **LICENCED AND INSURED CATERER.**

Copies of the caterer's M.A.S.T Permit, Liquor Liability Insurance certificate, and WA State banquet permit must be submitted to Sprinker no later than 2 weeks prior to the event.

### **Insurance WA State Banquet Permit**

No kegs or champagne fountains are allowed.

Groups serving alcohol that are expecting over 200 people must pay for off duty police services for entire event. One additional officer for every 100 persons over 200. Groups serving alcohol that understate their attendance may have their event canceled and lose their deposit if police services are not secured.

Alcoholic beverages must be consumed in the permitted room only.

Bring your own alcohol functions are not allowed. Such functions will be immediately shut down without a refund.

If patrons are found to be drinking and re-entering the function, the function will be immediately shut down without a refund.

Groups will be expected to reimburse the Center for any of the following:

- Lost or damaged equipment
- Any area requiring additional cleaning
- Parking lot clean up
- Vandalism

Pierce County Park's staff has the authority to have an individual(s) of the event removed if their actions are deemed inappropriate, disorderly, disrespectful or if they are overly intoxicated. Failure by the person in charge to have the individual(s) in question immediately removed from the function will be cause to shut down the entire event without their deposit refunded. In the event this action is taken the Pierce County Sheriff's Department will be contacted.

No alcoholic beverage shall be served or consumed to any person under 21 years of age. Groups found violating will be immediately shut down without a refund.
