SUMMARY OF REQUIREMENTS TO OBTAIN A FIREWORKS PERMIT

FIREWORKS DISPLAY - 1.4G (FBPD)

SUBMITTALS REQUIRED:

- Completed permit application
- Detailed site plan (1 electronic copy or 2 paper copies)
- Quantities
- Type of fireworks
- Display permit fee = \$110.00
- Shall provide 24 hour emergency contact name and telephone number
- Display shall be in accordance with WAC 212-17, RCW 70.77 and Pierce County Code 17C.60

After your application has been created, our office will send an email to the applicant at the address provided, with a link for payment.

Please allow at least 15 working days prior to event for PC Fire Prevention plan review and approval of permit application. Fire Prevention Bureau inspection may be required.

A “private” display permit is for 1.4g consumer “common” fireworks being used between July 6th and June 28th (outside of Washington State’s legal fireworks discharge period). All displays using such devices are considered “private” displays, whether intended for viewing by private individuals or groups, or the general public.

Private fireworks display permits are issued only for cultural and/or religious events, or similar purposes with the approval of the Fire Marshal.

NOTE: In the event of a burn ban, restrictions may apply.

NOTE: Sale and purchase of fireworks December 27 through December 31 are prohibited in unincorporated Pierce County.
